RE: GUIDELINES ON THE SELECTION OF 2019 NATIONAL POOL & 2019 SEA GAMES PLAYERS

FROM: SECRETARY GENERAL

- 1) The tabulated points in the OPEN ROUND/SENIOR DIVISION of the following tournaments, using the 2017 Philippine Cup Point System, will be the bases in the selection process for the candidates of the 2019 National Pool:
  - 2018 Philippine Cup Series [Leg 1, Leg 2 and Leg 3]
  - 2018 Philippine National Open (FR Sevilla, March 2018)
  - 2018 Philippine National Games (Danao-Cebu, April 2018)
  - 2018 Philippine Archery Festival (Baguio City-Benguet, September 2018)
  - 2019 Philippine National Open (venue to be announced)
  - 2019 Philippine Cup Series [Leg 1, Leg 2 and Leg 3] (venues to be announced)
- 2) All other tournaments that have not yet been conducted, will be scheduled between January June 2019.
- 3) Out of the 10 tournaments mentioned-above, only the 5 highest points of each archer will be used to rank the candidates.
- 4) Those who did not reached the minimum of 5 tournaments will not be included in the selection process.
- 5) The top 10 ranking archers in each category, based on their 5 highest points, will be placed as candidates of the 2019 National Pool of Archers.
- 6) The Top 10 ranking archers in each category (Open Round/Senior Division) will compose of the following:
  - 5.1) Recurve Women Category:
    - 3 women Senior Division
    - 7 women Junior Division
  - 5.2) Recurve Men category:
    - 3 men Senior Division
    - 7 men Junior Division
  - 5.3) Compound Women Category:
    - 3 women Senior Division
    - 7 women Junior Division
  - 5.4) Compound Men Category:
    - 3 men Senior Division
    - 7 men Junior Division

- 7) Archers who want or plan to be in the Top 10 must compete in the open round/senior division, where all archers will be competing on the same field of play with the same conditions and the tournament is conducted at the same time. Not during the Junior Division competition.
- 8) Upon naming the top 10 archers of each category, each archer must sign an undertaking or agreement with WAP before they will be accepted and are qualified to attend the series of evaluation tournaments to be scheduled by WAP.
- 9) WAP will release a list of requirements and modified guidelines for the series of evaluation tournaments which will explain new ranking procedures in selecting the 2019 National Team/Pool Members.
- 10) After the series of evaluation tournaments, scores will be ranked accordingly. The Top 4 archers in each category will compose the 2019 National Team Members.
- 11) The remaining 6 archers in each category will be placed as substitute archers or members of the pool of archers.
- 12) In the event if any among the top 4 archers will:
  - not conform to or abide by WAP's rules and regulations;
  - not have the capacity to perform at peak due to reasons ranging from medical, personal and the likes;
  - not be able to maintain or better their scores;

the next ranking archer among the substitutes will take over the position.
